PETITION FOR CERTIFICATION OF
MATERIALITY OF OUT OF STATE WITNESS

Now come the People of the State of Illinois by Assistant State's Attorney William G. Workman, and moves this Court for a Certificate of Materiality of an Out of State Witness, and as grounds therefore would show:

1. Misook Nowlin has been indicted in the McLean County Circuit Court with the offenses of three counts of Murder and one count of Concealment of Homicidal Death, in case number 2011CF000800.

2. The Charging Indictments filed in this cause alleged that the above-named defendant, Misook Nowlin, committed the offense of Murder in that she knowingly and without lawful justification killed Wenlan Linda Tyda, a person over sixty years of age, by applying pressure to Tyda's neck and in performing the acts that caused the death of Wenlan Linda Tyda the defendant intended to kill or do great bodily harm to Wenlan Linda Tyda; and, Murder in that she knowingly and without lawful justification killed Wenlan Linda Tyda, a person over sixty years of age, by applying pressure to Tyda's neck and in performing the acts that caused the death of Wenlan Linda Tyda the defendant knew her acts created a strong probability of death to Wenlan Linda Tyda; and, Murder in that she knowingly and without lawful justification killed Wenlan Linda Tyda, a person over sixty years of age, by applying pressure to Tyda's neck and in performing the acts that caused the death of Wenlan Linda Tyda the defendant knew her acts created a strong probability of great bodily harm to Wenlan Linda Tyda; and, Concealment of Homicidal Death in that she knowingly concealed the death of Wenlan Linda Tyda with knowledge that Wenlan Linda Tyda died by homicidal means.

3. Michelle Nowlin, resides at 189 Southridge, Westfield, IN 46074.

4. A Jury Trial in the case of People v. Misook Nowlin is scheduled to commence on December 10, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.


5. Michelle Nowlin is a necessary and material witness for the People of the State of Illinois in the aforementioned cause in that she is a material witness of the incident and provided statements to investigators.

6. The presence of Michelle Nowlin will be needed within McLean County for no longer than one day.

7. Should Michelle Nowlin come to the State of Illinois pursuant to an Order directing her to appear and testify in this cause, the laws of the State of Illinois will give her protection from arrest and the service of criminal or civil process in connection with matters which arose before her entrance in to the State of Illinois, pursuant to said Order.

8. The State of Illinois will tender \$20.00 per day and \$.20 per mile to Michelle Nowlin as costs of transportation to and from Illinois.

WHEREFORE, the People of the State of Illinois, by and through Assistant State's Attorney William G. Workman, requests the Court issue a certificate under seal setting forth the materiality and the number of days the witness will be required to be present in order to testify in the trial of the above-captioned cause. This request is made pursuant to ILCS, Chapter 725, Sections 220/3 through 220/6 which is reciprocal in its terms with the State of Indiana Statutes to secure the attendance of witnesses from within or without a state in criminal proceedings.


