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I went to Mi Sook's apartment I think around -- I A don't quite recall what time, eight, or 8:15, or 8:30ish, and I just stopped by. They were over there, and I asked them if they wanted to shoot some pool.

Okay. I'm sorry, let me back up. You went to Mi Sook's apartment. Is that correct?

A Yes.

And Susie Kaiar was there when you got there. that right?

A Right.

What happened after that?

All they just sitting around over there, and I stop by very often, my girl friend, and I ask them if they want to go, you know, shoot some pool, and they did go with me.

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Do you remember talking to some police officers about this situation a few days after Christina was found dead?

A Yeah, I got a call from Detective Larry Shepherd, and I went to police office and he asked me some questions.

Q Okay. Do you remember telling Detective Shepherd that you went first to the billiards center. Mi Sook and Susie changed their mind and showed up a short time later. Do you think you might have told him that?

A I don't believe so.

Q After you finished at the billiards center, did you go back to Mi Sook's?

A Yes.

- Q Did you go inside or stay for any length of time?
- A I don't quite remember. I thought I just dropped them off and went home.
- Q Did you see from, or hear from, or have any contact with Mi Sook then later that evening or before daylight the next morning?
  - A Shouldn't, but I don't really recall.
